

10 am Meeting was called to order by President Chuck Youngquist.

Secretary's Report: Secretary's report was read by Jenn Pritchard. Meeting minutes approved on a Dennis/Bill W. motion.

Building Permit for construction/addition: The club has received the building/construction permit. Mike updated that construction will start after Labor Day.
