Bills and Correspondence:

Al S. submitted a check for deposit as payment for grooming.

Old Business:

Al S let us now that trail #3 is packed, brushed and he took down a several trees too. He and a few other members ran the trails on snow mobiles and they are looking great. The water holes are flooded again to about 6 inches deep. We will need a plan to work with the town to fix that area and put in some culverts. Mike suggested using some caution signs to alert trail users to the conditions of that area. Discussion on fixing the excessive water/flooding ensued.

Meat Raffles - They have been moved to the Viewpoint for the month of December. They are scheduled for December 7th and December 21st. They will return to the Chipmunk in January. The meat is from Superior Meats and the raffle will consist of 8 rounds of \$1 a ticket. Discussion occurred on bonus rounds and 50/50 drawings. 30th Anniversary - There was a discussion on our 30th anniversary of our club. An open house was discussed, and a plan began.
